

## At the Lake Corrections

### Cutting Instructions

From Yellow (5" x 21")

Cut one strip 4 1/2" x 9 1/2" (a)

Cut one strip 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" (b)

Cut one strip 4 1/2" x 3 1/2" (c)

From Yellow/Orange (5" x 14")

Cut 4 strips 2" x 4 1/2" (d)

Cut 1 strip 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" (e)

From Red/Orange (5" x 14")

Cut 4 strips 2" x 4 1/2" (f)

Cut 1 strip 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" (g)

From Red (5" x 14")

Cut 4 strips 2" x 4 1/2" (h)

Cut 1 strips 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" (i)

From Red 2 (3" x 11")

Cut 2 strips 2" x 2 1/2" (j)

Cut 2 strips 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" (k)

From Purple (5" x 6")

Cut 2 strips 2" x 2 1/2" (l)

From Green: Cut one strip 3" x 9 1/2"

From Turquoise: Cut one strip 4" x 9 1/2"

From Medium Blue: Cut one strip 4" x 9 1/2"

From Navy: Cut one strip 5" x 9 1/2"

Follow the layout provided to stitch the strips together into rows, and the rows together into the background of the runner.

Trace the illustration of the heron onto fusible transfer web.

Follow the manufacturers instructions to fuse the web onto the wrong side of a black cotton fabric.

Cut out the shape of the heron, and place onto the background you have pieced. Applique however you choose, with a small zig zag stitch, a satin stitch, or by quilting as you applique, in a raw edge method.

Place this row into your quilt, or add borders, and binding, and make this project into a banner for your home, or lake home, "At the Lake".
